Mission

- ➔ To help people in need of free air transportation for medical and humanitarian purposes.

2023 Statistics

- ➔ Per its most recent audit, 96% of funds contributed to Angel Flight South Central go directly to supporting passengers, placing it well above the industry standard of 75% as stated by Charity Navigator
- ➔ AFSC cost per mission = \$145
- ➔ AFSC cost per passenger = \$92
- ➔ 297 volunteer pilots flew 2,864 mission legs
- ➔ 648,910 miles were flown
- ➔ Passenger demographics: 95% adult and 5% children; 55% female and 45% male

What Does Angel Flight South Central Do?

- ➔ Provides FREE air travel through a network of volunteer pilots who donate ALL costs of a flight – including plane, time, and fuel
- ➔ Serves those in need of medical care and humanitarian support in its five-state region
- ➔ Partners with sister organizations within the Air Charity Network and Air Care Alliance to transport passengers needing critical services outside of its five-state region

What Type of Missions Are Flown?

- ➔ Medical care and treatments
- ➔ Disaster relief
- ➔ Blood and organ transplants
- ➔ CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) volunteers supporting foster children in remote areas
- ➔ Relocation for victims of domestic abuse or human trafficking

Who are Angel Flight South Central's Pilots?

- ➔ Minimum 250 hours of PIC time
- ➔ Access to personal aircraft
- ➔ Experimental aircraft are welcome, but only permitted to fly non-passenger missions at this time
- ➔ Currently liability insurance, pilot certificate, and medical
